NOTIFICATION

Subject: Revision of Annual Accreditation Fee for NABH Ayush Accreditation Program

The National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers (NABH) introduced Accreditation Program for Ayush Hospitals in 2009 with the intent of promoting quality and patient safety in Ayush healthcare sector. Since the inception of the program, the fee structure under this program has remained unchanged. However, considering the rise in daily operational costs, evolving market conditions, and the recent revision of fee across other NABH programs, the annual accreditation fee has been revised as per the categories of sanctioned bed strength, the details of which are provided below. However, the application fee for all bed categories remains unchanged.

The revised fee structure will come into effect from 1st January 2026, which means it will apply to all Ayush healthcare organizations with due date of accreditation fee payment falling after 1st January 2026.
