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Problem Statement / Digital Challenge

- Limited visibility due to multiple locations, challenges in data validation, lengthy audit durations, and lack of staff accountability

Why was a digital solution required?

- To ensure 100% compliance with equipment checklist
- To eliminate manual errors in audits.
- To enable real - time visibility & traceability
- To Improve emergency preparedness.
- To Meet NABH standards

- Strong adoption came from piloting first, then scaling nationwide.
- Emergency preparedness strengthened with frequent crash cart audits.

Suggestions for Other Hospitals

- Begin with small pilots before expansion.
- Provide training & handholding to staff.
- Secure leadership and cross-team support.

Replicability

- Scalable to multi-location hospital networks.
- Can be adapted for NABH digital health compliance and emergency preparedness monitoring.
